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The *continuum* is hermetic. How then does the *object of desire* commute from the *continuum* to those who experience desire firsthand? Be it known that the *continuum* comprises a non-empty set of natural numbers that have the property of being undesirable, and due to the well-ordered property of natural numbers, there must be a smallest number in the set of undesirable numbers. Being the smallest number of the set, by definition the least undesirable of all, the number is at once desirable and undesirable, which is a contradiction.

Therefore: Blotsplotch. *Argumentum ad absurdum.*

(Blotsplotch . . . Blotsplotch . . .
Blotsplotch only wants the virus of lights.)
